The S/Y Frøia was originally a sloop, built in Hardanger, Norway in 1857. She is probably one of the worlds ten oldest vessels still afloat and undoubtedly the oldest ship in use purely for commercial purposes. After extensive restoration, the Frøia is an outstanding treasure among today's maritime vessels.

Onboard the Frøia, modern comfort is discreetly combined with 19century charm, and this is well-maintained by the service crew who create a friendly and informal atmosphere. The spacious flush deck has become popular as a dance floor where music is provided.
